Fire Control 3: Structural Fire Fighting

(CA State Certified)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course provides the knowledge and skills that prepare a fire fighter to locate, control, and extinguish an interior structure fire.

PREREQUISITES: Meet the minimum job performance requirements for Fire Fighter 1 in NFPA 1001: Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications related to safety; fire behavior; portable extinguishers; personal protective equipment (PPE); ladders; fire hose, appliances, and streams; overhaul; water supply; ventilation; forcible entry; and building construction (NFPA 1403 (2018)) or SFT Fire Fighter 1 certification

Students must be currently employed by a fire department, law enforcement, military agency, or private organization that deals with live fire operations. ****Students must provide their own NFPA compliant structural PPE and SCBA. A letter from your supervisor endorsing your enrollment in the course must also be provided on day one of the class. Students must provide proof of a current mask FIT test to participate in the class.**
