Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior

(CA State Certified)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: S290 is a 32-hour course designed to meet training requirements to work in the operation section of the Incident Command System. This course is a “skill” course that is designed to instruct prospective fire line supervisors in wildland fire behavior for effective and safe fire management operations. Topics: Environment, basic weather process; use of Belt Weather Kit, humidity, winds, keeping current weather, topographical influences, fuels, moisture, wildland fire behavior in the third dimension, wildland fire environmental factors and indicators.
