Dear Fire Academy Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the 41st Heartland Fire Academy. We hope this academy will help you in preparation for a career in the Fire Service. The Heartland Fire Academy consists of Southwestern Community College courses (FS-281F, FS-281G & FS32) and various certification courses that are accredited by the California State Fire Marshal. Upon successful completion of the Heartland Fire Academy and the additional required SFT courses, students will receive a State Fire Training Firefighter 1 Certificate, and earn twenty (20) Southwestern Community College Fire Technology units.

The Heartland Fire Academy includes lecture-based classroom sessions on topics such as *firefighter safety, equipment operation, fire extinguishers, forcible entry tools and techniques, lifting and hoisting equipment, fire hose, hose nozzles and fittings, hose evolutions, ladders, breathing apparatus, fire control, fire prevention, and more*. Manipulative classes give recruits the opportunity to practice skills taught in the classroom.

ACADEMY INFORMATION

- **Academy 41 is a 540-hour course; start date will be Monday, August 24th, 2026 at 7:00 am**
- **This course meets Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**
- Class locations will be the Heartland Fire Training Facility and other off-site locations

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years of age at time of academy start date & High school graduate or equivalent (GED)
- EMT-B or Public Safety-First Aid (*completed by academy start date*)

PREREQUISITE CERTIFICATIONS

- WMD/Terrorism Awareness for first responders (available online at teex.org)
- ICS IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, IS-800 (available online at teex.org)
- CPAT completion no older than 12 months at time of acceptance to academy

ACADEMY FEES

Additional costs associated with the fire academy

(recruits are responsible for all of the costs below, paid directly to vendors)

SCBA, FIT test, Structural PPE, Wildland PPE	\$ 1,300.00
Medical respiratory exam (required prior to academy orientation)	\$ 200.00
Class B Uniform and Boots *Approximately*	\$ 350.00

Each recruit will be required to have the appropriate uniforms and personal protective equipment prior to the start of the Academy. Once accepted to the Academy, each recruit will receive detailed information on the specifications and type of uniforms and safety gear. These costs will be paid by the student directly to the vendor.

SELECTION PROCESS

- **Submit Application by June 30, 2026 deadline:** If your application is approved, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified if you are selected for an interview with academy personnel.
- **Interview:** Each *Open Enrollee candidate* must pass an oral Interview Board. Interviews will be held virtually, via Zoom. Interviews will last approximately fifteen minutes.
- **Medical Examination:** If accepted, information will be provided to each candidate.
- **Mask Fit Test.** All mask fit tests will be completed during academy orientation.
- **Physical Abilities Test:** Candidates must have a valid CPAT card *dated no older than 12 months before the academy start date*. See <http://www.cffjac.org/go/jac/cpat/> for more information.

CONDUCT

The Academy is conducted in a paramilitary format and every effort will be made for the success of all candidates. Candidates are expected to adhere to all rules of conduct which include appropriate appearance and grooming standards

PHYSICAL TRAINING

Physical Training is an important component of the Academy. All candidates must be in good physical condition before entering the Academy. *At a minimum, a candidate should be able to perform to the following standards on the first day of the Academy:* 1.5 mile run / 5 story stair climb with 25lbs on each shoulder / 25 Pushups in one minute / 30 Sit-Ups in one minute / 5 pull-ups / 5 chin-ups / 50 yard farmer carry with 40lbs in each hand
